A full day excursion to Weymouth, a classic Victorian resort with an impressive sweep of Georgian seafront buildings. Weymouth has so much to offer, from its restored Victorian Fort to the new town shopping centre together with a variety of restaurants, pubs, cafes, ice cream parlours and souvenir shops. The busy harbour features a bustling flotilla of fishing boats, pleasure craft and yachts.

We travel through the Ancient New Forest to Beaulieu. The Beaulieu Estate has been home to the Montagu family since 1538 and is also home to the world famous National Motor Museum. We include a guided tour of the Palace when you can find out about life in the ancestral home and learn something of its history from its monastic origins to the present day. We then continue to the unique and picturesque village of Buckler's Hard. The Maritime Museum, with its reconstructed 18th century cottage interiors, gives an insight into the history of the village and the river on which it stands.
