ITINERARY

Day 1 Travel to Lymington for the short 20 minute crossing to Yarmouth with Wightlink ferries before completing the journey to Sandown.

Day 2 – 7 At leisure in resort with the following included excursions.

A half day tour to Cowes and Osborne House (entry not included). In fact Cowes is two towns, one on each side of the River Medina, linked by a floating bridge. West Cowes is known for its yachts and fashion, while East Cowes has boatyards and industry. A mile long tree-lined road leads from the centre of East Cowes to Osborne House, a favourite residence of Queen Victoria. **5 & 8 day tour**

A half day tour to Newport, the capital of the island. A bustling town centre affording plenty of modern shopping. We then travel to Godshell, one of the most picturesque villages on the Isle of Wight. **5 & 8 day tour**

A full day Island tour visiting Shanklin, the twin resort of Sandown connected by a six mile stretch of sands. Built on a cliff top Shanklin is an ancient village with thatched cottages overgrown with honeysuckle. The Crab Inn dates back from the 17th Century and the poet John Keats lived there during the 19th Century. We continue our tour via Ventnor, viewing the spectacular coastal scenery before arriving at the multi-coloured cliffs of Alum Bay and the Needles before returning to Sandown. **8 day tour**

A half day tour to Ryde. Ryde faces the Solent towards Portsmouth and its half mile long pier, built in 1813 is the island's main entry point. The Town Hall in Lind Street has a colonnaded façade and a handsome clock tower.

Day 8 We travel to Yarmouth for the return ferry crossing to Lymington and complete the journey home.
